Get The Facts About Pinworm

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Pinworm is the most common worm infection in the United-States. Cases of pinworm infection are seen most often at schools, day care centers and other institutional settings. School-age children, followed by preschoolers, have the highest rates of infection.

What Is Pinworm?

Pinworm is an intestinal infection caused by a tiny, white, highly contagious intestinal worm (Enterobius Vermicularis) that looks like a thread and measures about 1/2" (1 cm) in length. It is the most common intestinal parasite in the United States and exists year-round, especially in warm, moist climates.

How Do Children Get Infected?

Pinworms are spread when an infected person, most often a child, has scratched their bare and the eggs get under their fingernails. They can then be spread to others a number of ways.

- By an infected child not washing their hands after using the bathroom. If the child then touches playmates or toys, they may pass along the eggs.
- Pinworm eggs can be transferred to the fingers from clothing or bedding, and then spread around the home.
- Eggs may be inhaled from the air or deposited onto food and swallowed.
- Pinworms can survive up to two weeks on clothing, bedding or other objects, if kept at room temperature.

How To Identify A Pinworm Infection

If pinworms are suspected, you can confirm infestation by performing the "Scotch® Tape Test". Collect anal debris by pressing a piece of tape against the skin around the anus and examine it for the presence of eggs or worms. The tape test should be done in the middle of the night or first thing in the morning before bathing or using the toilet to minimize the disturbance or removal of the eggs.

How To Eliminate Pinworm

Pinworm infection is fully treatable. The best way to eliminate pinworms is to use an over-the-counter Pyrantel Pamoate-based medication such as *Reese's Pinworm Medicine*. *Reese's* products are highly effective for eliminating pinworms—usually with just one dose. Because pinworms are contagious, all family members need to be treated at the same time. Several children can

be easily treated with a single bottle of *Reese's Pinworm Medicine*. If the household is large, or has two or more adults, more than one 1-oz bottle, or a 2-oz Family Pack may be required.
